Monthly breakfasts.....

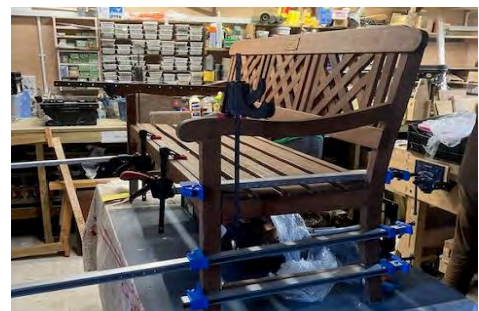

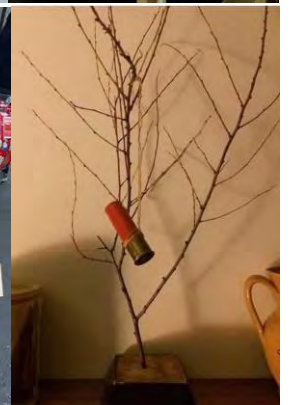
